Illinois Clinic Stretches KodiakCare Dollars to Save a Life

Veterinarians struggling to reduce health-care costs around the world could learn a lesson from KodiakCare's partners at the <u>Illinois Medical District Veterinary Clinic in Chicago</u>.

This small, non-emergency animal hospital in a busy urban neighborhood has learned to make the most of funding – fortunately for Chon, a poodle-terrier mix, cured of a near-deadly parvovirus infection at a fraction of the typical cost with help from KodiakCare.

Dr. Drew Sullivan, Medical Director at the University of Illinois-affiliated clinic, takes a creative approach to the financial limitations of his patients. "You can still practice very good medicine *and* figure out what's absolutely necessary," he said.

Now that KodiakCare has partnered with his clinic, "Having some funds makes a huge difference," he said. "Sometimes it's not the big ticket items like 3 days in a hospital. It might be \$600 that saves the pet, but the [owners] are so thankful you can work within the budget."

Chon comes from a loving family with very limited resources, and Dr. Sullivan adjusted his treatment accordingly. The stricken pooch would typically have been hospitalized for at least 24 hours on IV fluids, but overnight care at a hospital can be extremely expensive. Instead, Dr. Sullivan pumped Chon full of meds and fluids, then sent him home to rest each night under the care of owner Amairani Alvarado, who then returned Chon to the clinic each morning.

Dr. Sullivan grew up in the farm country of central Illinois seeing veterinary care that was effective, but, as he put it, "not what they're teaching you in school." He learned to make many a diagnosis without CT scans or MRIs, for instance, and to forgo costly overnight care when possible. Even small-ticket items that can make the difference between life and death, like a simple course of antibiotics, might be unaffordable for needy dog owners at his clinic.

Even with Dr. Sullivan's creative care for Chon, Alvarado and her family couldn't afford the multiple visits to the clinic and medication that Chon needed to survive. Thanks to a \$1,000 contribution from KodiakCare, Chon is fully recovered and back to his old mischievous self. "We cherish him like our little brother," said Alvarado. Alvarado was so "grateful for Dr. Sullivan and the donors out there that help families" like hers through these difficult times. "It was sad going through something like that. It makes you appreciate life and your loved ones more."
